Symptoms



People infected with RSV usually show symptoms within 4 to 6 days after getting infected and include: Runny nose, decrease in appetite, coughing, sneezing, fever, and wheezing

Care



Managing fever and pain with acetaminophen or ibuprofen, drinking enough fluids, and talking to your healthcare provider

RSV Transmission



An infected person coughs, sneezes or touches a surface that has the virus on it and then touches your face, making direct contact with someone with RSV

RSV Prevention



Cover your coughs and sneezes, wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, avoid close contact with others, and clean frequently touched surfaces
